



Voluntary Climate Actions to Sustain Economic GrowthSM



Power PartnersSM EEI Member Company Participants

The shareholder-owned electric companies listed below—all member companies of the Edison Electric Institute (EEI)—are active participants in Power PartnersSM, a new joint government-industry partnership with the Department of Energy to develop and implement voluntary climate actions to sustain economic growth.

Individual company actions will comprise the cornerstone of EEI's pledge to voluntarily reduce, avoid, and sequester greenhouse gas emissions. Among these activities will likely be: additional natural gas and clean coal technology generation; additional nuclear generation; additional renewable energy, energy efficiency, and wise electricity use programs; and additional tree planting, methane projects, and international projects to offset CO₂.

Supplementing individual company efforts, EEI members also will participate in several industry-wide initiatives, including CO₂ sequestration/forestry projects; increased use of coal combustion products; harvesting of wind power and biomass for electricity generation; and development of international power partnerships that focus on climate and sustainable development.

EEI member companies participating in Power PartnersSM represent nearly 90 percent of the electric generation produced by the Institute's members. The Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) is a member of Power PartnersSM but is not a shareholder-owned electric company.
