New Jersey: Incentive/Demand Response Programs

Smart Start Buildings – The New Jersey Smart Start Buildings program is administered by the NJ Board of Public Utilities Office of Clean Energy and is available to all Atlantic City Electric commercial and industrial customers in southern New Jersey who are building, renovating or remodeling a facility or replacing existing equipment. New construction must be located within a designated Smart Growth area.

Through the New Jersey Smart Start Buildings program, Atlantic City Electric commercial and industrial customers can receive design and technical assistance, as well as equipment incentives for installing high-efficiency equipment in new construction projects.

From time to time, power outages occur for various reasons across Atlantic City Electric's service territory. In most cases, power is restored in less than two hours but sometimes, more serious outages are possible. Hurricanes, thunderstorms, ice storms, fierce winds, salt and extreme heat strain the power delivery system and can prolong power restoration. Atlantic City Electric's personnel are well trained and well prepared to handle such events as quickly and safely as possible. Energy Profiler Online puts your electric interval meter data at your fingertips, which is vital to many tasks:

- Analyzing usage for multiple sites or facilities;
- Reviewing usage data for energy choice decisions;
- Measuring the effectiveness of energy-efficiency efforts; and,
- Generating management reports.

Energy Profiler Online lets you see your data in either graph or table format. If you prefer, you can also download your interval data in a fixed format, readable by spreadsheet or database applications. From that, you can create your own customized reports and graphs.
