SERVICE TERRITORY:

Entergy-Arkansas provides electric service in 64 of Arkansas' 75 counties. Entergy-GS serves an area of Louisiana extending westward from Baton Rouge to the Texas border. The service area encompasses major cities such as Lake Charles and Baton Rouge. Large Commercial & Industrial Standard Offer Quick Start Program: The Large Commercial & Industrial (C&I) Standard Offer Quick Start program is an energy efficiency program designed to provide financial incentives to large C&I customers for the installation of a wide range of energy efficiency measures that reduce peak demand loads in their facilities.

Large Commercial & Industrial Energy Solutions Quick Start Program: The Large Commercial & Industrial (C&I) Energy Solutions Quick Start Program is an energy efficiency program designed to provide assistance and financial incentives to large C&I customers for the installation of certain energy efficiency measures that reduce peak demand load in their facilities.

Large Commercial and Industrial Demand Response Quick Start Program: The Large Commercial and Industrial Demand Response Quick Start Program consists of programs that encourage a change in energy usage by a customer from normal consumption patterns in response to changes in the price of energy over time. This program is available for customers who have and are willing to interrupt a minimum of 100 kW every month during on-peak hours.

Entergy-GS also sells electricity to municipalities and rural electric cooperatives in Louisiana. Parishes served include East Baton Rouge, West Baton Rouge, Acadia, Ascension, Calcasieu, Cameron, East Feliciana, West Feliciana, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, Livingston, Pointe Coupee, St. James, St. Landy, St. Martin and Vermilion. Entergy-GS electric system is interconnected with and operated as a part of Entergy Corporation, which supplies the electric energy requirements of more than 2.4 million retail customers in Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi and Texas.

Entergy-Louisiana provides electric service to approximately 760,000 customers in 43 parishes (counties) encompassing about 19,500 square miles in Louisiana including the cities of New Orleans and Monroe. Entergy-Mississippi serves 388,000 customers in an area consisting basically of the western half of the state. Key cities are Jackson, Vicksburg, Natchez, Brookhaven, McComb, Greenville, Cleveland, Grenada, Indianola and Southaven.

Entergy-Mississippi electric system is interconnected with and operated as a part of Entergy Corporation, which supplies the electric energy requirements of more than 2.4 million retail customers in Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi and Texas.

Entergy-GS serves 658,000 electric customers and 89,000 gas customer in an area of southeast Texas extending from the border to a point about 100 miles east of Austin. The service area encompasses the northern suburbs of Houston and major cities such as Conroe, Huntsville, Port Arthur, Orange and Beaumont.
