PROFESSIONAL/EDUCATIONAL CREDITS

SAFETY:

The Board of Certified Safety Professionals (BCSP) does not pre-approve any programs for Continuance of Certification (COC) credits. Meeting attendees holding the CSP designation should maintain a file of the meeting related materials and submit that information to the BCSP as part of the 5 year review and re-certification process. The BCSP will determine at that time the number of COC credits to be granted for the meetings.
